OUR INTENTION

The Education Impact Program seeks to lift children and families out of poverty through providing a quality pre-school through 7th grade education, laying the foundation for success in secondary school and beyond.

In a region where it is estimated that 30% of the adult population can neither read nor write, where books are virtually non-existent, the Ubora Education Team has brought books and inspiration for the joy of reading. In a curriculum based primarily on memorization, the Ubora team has mentored teaching for meaning and understanding. Test scores are rapidly improving, and both teachers and students have discovered a joy in learning that has been transformational.

- Education at Siha Leadership School is excellent, exciting and engaging reaching students with all learning styles! Teachers actively participate in regular training and ongoing mentoring groups for both content and metholodogy.
- Siha Leadership Primary School (SLS)
 consistently ranks in the top 10% of primary
 schools in the country.
- 100% of SLS 7th graders have passed the National Leaving Exam since the school opened.
- 191 of SLS students have gone on to graduate from secondary school.
- 32 of SLS students have gone on to graduate from university.
- 6 former students are pursuing degrees in medicine
