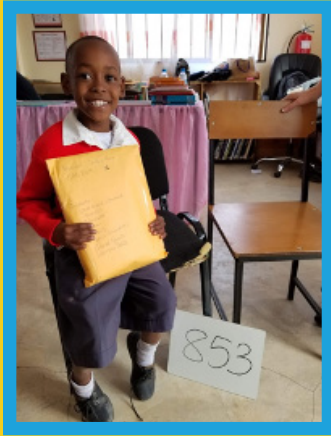

IMPACT PROGRAM

Project Child



Uborá believes that a high quality, Christian, educational-based sponsorship program is key to setting up the children of the Siha District for success. Project Child matches a sponsor with a child, beginning with pre-school (4 years old) at Siha Leadership Pre and Primary School, continuing through graduation from select secondary boarding schools. Besides an excellent Christian education, each child receives clothing, two healthy meals per day, health monitoring and a sponsor who assists in meeting the child's needs and the needs of his or her family.

OUR INTENTION

Project Child seeks to facilitate the building of relationships across the so-called barriers of culture, language, and geography. We desire to see sponsors' hearts changed as they get to know their child through letters and video calls, learning that these simple acts can truly set a child on a different path in life. We desire for the children to be encouraged as they learn that they are unique creations of God with great potential.

OUR INSPIRATION

"Without Uborá and SLS, there would be nothing." These heartfelt words were spoken by Fides, one of our graduates who came to us fatherless, she and her siblings being raised by their struggling mother. The teachers at the school encouraged her.

Her family received aid. And Fides thrived. Today, Fides is at the Faraja Health Training Institute in preparation for medical school. She is forever grateful to her sponsors who made her dream of being a doctor possible.

OUR IMPACT

- 648 children have gone through or are currently in the Uborá Project Child program
- 348 students have graduated Standard 7 and have gone on to secondary school
- 600 meals a day are served to our students (breakfast and lunch)
- All children receive an annual physical from the Uborá medical team
- The children in Standards 4 and 7 receive vision and hearing screenings at the local health clinic
- All children monitored by on-site social worker who tracks absenteeism, illness, and other issues and follows up with the child's family
- The Uborá Project Child sponsorship program fully funds the Siha Leadership School operation and the cost of our students' secondary school education
